

“This is a Bible”

Course Objective:

Acts 18:11 And he continued there a year and six months, teaching the word of God among them.

1. To be able to explain the entire Bible history succinctly. “Know your Bible forward and backward”
2. Gain a macro understanding of the Bible. “Context is key to understanding the Bible”
3. Use homework assignments to stretch Bible study skills and develop critical thinking. “Learn to think biblically”
4. Develop confidence in biblical understanding. “Know what you believe!”

What you will need:

Class participation

The homework assignments will require the following:

- An e-mail account.
- Access to a computer for word processing.
- Study Bible, Concordance, Bible Dictionary, and basic Bible study tools.

Homework Procedures:

1. Weekly written assignments are due by 10:00 p.m. Saturday—emailed to gunkel1@me.com.
2. The written testimony must be typed in Times New Roman 12 font, no minimum or maximum word count. Double spaced. Name and title page. Must be in Word or Pages format.
3. Memorizing the names of the books of the Bible: at the beginning of the class volunteers will be asked to recite the homework due.
4. Oral report - Starting May 5th, each student will be randomly called on to give the history of the entire Bible in 6 minutes or less. You may choose what format to use: Main Events, Main Character, 9 Covenants, or 7 dispensations. You may use note cards or outline, but not allowed to read the notes word for word. The idea is to know it by heart!
