## A man after God’s own heart

---

### Course Objective

**1 Sam 13:14** But now your kingdom shall not continue. The LORD has sought for Himself a man after His own heart, and the LORD has commanded him to be commander over His people, because you have not kept what the LORD commanded you.”

**Acts 13:22** And when He had removed him, He raised up for them David as king, to whom also He gave testimony and said, “I have found David the son of Jesse, a man after My own heart, who will do all My will.’

1. Investigate why God considered David a man after His own heart.
  2. Get to know one of the most prominent men in the Bible.
  3. Learn from David’s successes and failures in order to apply them to our life.
  4. To gain a deeper understanding of the Bible.
