# "King David" A man after God's own heart

#### **Course Objective**

1 Sam 13:14 But now your kingdom shall not continue. The LORD has sought for Himself a man after His own heart, and the LORD has commanded him to be commander over His people, because you have not kept what the LORD commanded you."

Acts 13:22 And when He had removed him, He raised up for them David as king, to whom also He gave testimony and said, "I have found David the son of Jesse, a man after My own heart, who will do all My will."

- I. Investigate why God considered David a man after His own heart.
- 2. Get to know one of the most prominent men in the Bible.
- 3. Learn from David's successes and failures in order to apply them to our life.
- 4. To gain a deeper understanding of the Bible.
