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## Course Description:

This course examines the factors that determine lasting fruit in a believer's life and ministry. Using a pyramid framework, students will explore the foundational elements that contribute to enduring spiritual impact, including love, empathy, vision, sacrifice, intentional teaching, and wisdom through the guidance of the Holy Spirit. Through biblical reflection, discussion, and practical application, the course will consider how these elements work together to shape character, influence others, and produce fruit that remains. The goal is to help students understand and cultivate the conditions that lead to lasting fruit.
